When: November 20 Coaches Meeting – 6:30 p.m.
21 Contest – 7:30 a.m.
22 Awards Breakfast – 8:30 a.m.

Where: Oklahoma State Fairgrounds, Oklahoma City, OK

Who: Junior (2yr) College teams of 3 or 4
Senior (4yr) College teams of 4 or 5

Deadline: October 19th

Not only the title of the “World Champion Collegiate Horse Judging Team” but also thousands of dollars in scholarships will be awarded to the top three teams in each division!

Here are some additional points to remember:

- * A current AQHA Membership is now required to compete in the contest. We are offering a discounted annual membership fee of \$40 for all contestants who need to purchase a membership. Amateur Memberships May Also Be Purchased For \$50. Please see attached form.
- * Only complete entry forms will be accepted. Last minute changes can be made at the coaches meeting.
- * Entry fee for contest is \$125 per team.
- * Entry fee for an individual in Junior and Senior College *or* Limited Division is \$25.
- * You may fax your entries **by October 15th** to (806) 349-6412 Attn: Sarah Smiddy.
- * Pick up your admission packet at the Horse Show Office which will include badges for team members and coaches who pre-registered (additional badges can be purchased at the Horse Show Office). The Horse Show Office is located in the Superbarn, next to the “Gateway of Champions.”

2013 AQHA World Championship
Collegiate Horse Judging Contest
November 20, 21, & 22, 2013

Eligibility

- A. Participants must be full-time undergraduate students in good standing as determined by their school requirements. A minimum grade point average of 2.5/4.0 (ct.) is recommended. Participants may not be an approved judge of any national horse association.
- B. Any two-year junior or four-year senior college or university may participate in the contest. There will be separate divisions for junior and senior colleges/universities.
- C. Contestants may only compete once in their lifetime in the junior college division and once in the senior college division.
- D. Participants must be current members of the American Quarter Horse Association. The AQHA Membership number for each team member must be provided on the contest entry form. If you have team members who are not current AQHA members, a new membership or renewal must be purchased at time of entry (\$40) and submitted on the form provided with the entry packet. Amateur Memberships May Also Be Purchased For \$50. This is not an online offer.
- E. **Junior College Division**
 - 1. Each school may enter two teams.
 - 2. Teams will consist of no more than four (4) members and not less than three (3) members.
 - 3. Four-member teams will have an alternate option with the lowest score in each division (performance, halter, reasons, and overall) being discarded. However, the alternate is eligible for individual awards. Three-member teams will not have an alternate option.
- F. **Limited Division**
 - 1. Students may participate in the Limited Division if they have not actively participated in a Junior or Senior College team in the regular (current division).
 - 2. Students will judge as individuals only, with no team awards given.
 - 3. There will be no limit on number of entries from an individual school.
 - 4. Participants will not be separated by junior or senior college.
 - 5. Awards will be given from 1st through 10th place in performance, halter and overall. Awards in the form of ribbons will be provided for by NHJTCA so as to not overly burden the host organization with extra costs.
 - 6. Entry fees for the Limited Division will be set by the host organization.
 - 7. Two sets of reasons will be given from the approved list of classes. Reasons takers will be selected from available coaches.
- G. **Senior College Division**
 - 1. Each school may enter two teams.
 - 2. Team will consist of no more than five (5) members and not less than four (4) members.
 - 3. Five-member teams will have an alternate option with the lowest score in each division (performance, halter, reasons and overall) being discarded. However, the alternate is eligible for individual awards. Four-member teams will not have an alternate option.
- H. Individuals may judge and are eligible for individual awards; however, they must be enrolled in and be accompanied by a school with a full team.

- C. Reasons will be given on two halter classes and four performance classes. Performance classes with an (*) are possible reasons classes, and all Halter classes are possible reasons classes.

Disqualifications

- A. Any communication between contestants during a contest will be sufficient cause to eliminate the contestants from the contest.
- B. Teams arriving after the contest has begun will be disqualified. No member substitutions may be made after the contest begins.
- C. Any assistance given to a team member from any source other than contest officials or assistants will be sufficient cause to eliminate the team from the contest.

Equipment

- A. All contestants will provide their own writing instruments.
- B. Contestants may use clipboards and preprinted score sheets. However, both must be clean and free of any personal comments or marks.
- C. Contestants may use rulebooks during the contest. Questions regarding rules must be directed to the contest coordinator.

Awards

Awards will be given in each division, junior and senior as follows:

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

The American Quarter Horse Association will provide scholarship funding to the college or university of the World Champion Team, Reserve World Champion Team and Third-place teams in the junior and senior college divisions at the AQHA World Championship Collegiate Judging Contest. The award amounts listed below are for each division:

World Champion Team	\$2,000.00
Reserve World Champion Team	\$1,250.00
Third-place team	\$750.00

The scholarships will be awarded to the school in the name of the winning judging teams. The only qualification for these scholarships is as follows:

Such scholarship funds will be awarded to the respective colleges and universities on the condition that these funds are used exclusively for the education of a student or students in your college or university's animal science department or equine-related fields which are selected by the college or university, its scholarship organization, its professional livestock or equine interest fraternity or association, or faculty advisor of such organization.
