**LOCATION:** Storey Hill Farm

**FEES:** \$50 all-inclusive fee for the weekend event

**ITINERARY:** Friday evening: Bonfire social; Saturday: 8-9:30 a.m. continental breakfast, 9:30-12 warm-up trail ride that includes poker hand activity, 12-1 a light lunch will be served, 2-4 trail ride on Kawartha Trans Canada Trail, 4:30-5:30 fun activities, 5:30-6:30 enjoy a BBQ supper, 6:30 raffle and musical entertainment; Sunday: 8-9:30 pancake breakfast followed by ride on Kawartha Trans Canada Trail.

\*Participants must register on or before August 31, 2014

No charge for meals for youth 6 and under. Non-riders can purchase \$30 meal package or \$15 BBQ dinner.

**BACKGROUND:** The Kawartha Trans Canada Trail is a 44 km linear trail that travels east to west between Peterborough County and Region of Durham. It is a section of the Trans Canada Trail which consists of 21,500 km of trail designated for recreational use, spanning from coast to coast, with sections in every province and territory in the country. The trail is built on the old CNR bed and winds its way through the local farmland.

**STALLS:** \$30 for the weekend (shavings included)

**RENTAL HORSES:** N/A

**ADDITIONAL ACTIVITIES:** The KTCT is open to only hikers, cyclists and equestrians during summer months, so non-riders can also enjoy the trail. The world famous Peterborough Liftlock is only a half hour away from the ride to the site. There are lots of local tourist attractions and shopping opportunities in the nearby Peterborough/Lindsay/Bobcaygeon areas. It's also just a 30 minute drive to harness racing and OLG slots at Kawartha Downs.
