PENALTY I/2:

Tick or light touch of log; Hind legs skipping or coming together during lead change; Non-simultaneous lead change

PENALTY I:

Hitting or rolling log; Out of lead more than one stride either side of center point & between markers; Splitting the log (log between the 2 front feet or 2 hind feet at the lope; Break of gate at the walk or jog up to 2 strides

PENALTY 3:

Not performing the specific gait or stopping when called for in the pattern; Simple change of leads; Out of lead at or before the marker prior to the designated change area or out of lead at or after the marker after the designated change area; additional lead changes anywhere in pattern; In pattern I & III, failure to start the lope within 30 feet after crossing the log at the jog; Break of gait at walk or jog anywhere for more than 2 strides; Break of gait at the lope

PENALTY 5:

Out of lead beyond the next designated change area;

Definity **SCORE 0:**Use of more than I finger between reins; Use of 2 hands; Use of romal other than outlined; Performing obstacles incorrectly or other than specified order; Mo attempt to perform obstacle; Equipment failure; Excessively touching horse; Fall to ground; Failure to enter, exit or work obstacle from correct side or direction, including overturns of more than I/4 turn; Failure to work an obstacle other than how it is described; Outside boundary marker of arens or course area; 3rd refusal; Failure to demonstrate or course area; On line of travel, head consistently correct lead or gair; On line of travel, now or oner demonstrate correct loo low or over flexed, except in novice classes carried too low or over flexed, except in novice classes
